 Jekyll & Hyde and Primal Brewery - cool breweries


 The Bottle Tree - international flavors; chefs can accommodate food allergies. Great brunch. Award winning outdoor space!


 String Bean - wine shop with a butcher counter. Great sandwiches and salads. Flatbread with fig and balsamic is delicious. Outdoor seating with firepits available.



 Kevin Loftin Park - right on the water! Can launch paddle boards or rent kayaks(seasonally). New playground equipment too.

 Catawba River Antique Mall - 67,000 sq ft of antiques to goof around and see

 Friday Night Live - street party downtown Belmont with some rockin' music and cold drinks! Food trucks too. (typically April - July)

 Stowe Park - downtown Belmont, big playground, walking loop & seasonal events like Movies in the Park & Farmer's Market!

 Daniel Stowe Botanical Gardens - 450 acres of amazing! Tour the gardens or get married here. Neat lights at Christmas and year round exhibits.

 Whitewater Center - They offer whitewater rafting, kayaking, canoeing, rock climbing, mountain biking & hiking. There's also a ropes course, zip-line, restaurant & River Jam (live music).

 Crowders Mountain State Park - Great hike! Can see downtown Charlotte from the top.
